
UNDERSTANDING THE IMPACTS FROM DRUG-ABUSING PARENTS



ONE OUT OF FIVE DRUG-ABUSING PARENT HAS A CHILD WHO CAME INTO CONTACT WITH THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM



HAVING A DRUG-ABUSING MOTHER SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASES THE RISK OF THE CHILD OFFENDING



CRUCIAL AGE PERIOD FOR
INTERVENTION IS BETWEEN
11 - 14 YEARS OLD
PREVENTION EFFORTS HAVE TO
HAPPEN BEFORE 11 YEARS OLD



ABSENCE OF PARENTS AND LACK OF SUPERVISION ARE RISK FACTORS FOR THE CHILD
